Here's a model to follow when you do your presentation Thursday. I plan to film it - just so the Superintendent and Board can see what we do.

30-minute Presentation Format (Suggested)

1. **Intro** (5 minutes): Project name, objectives (what students will do, what that will do for them), technology (why you used computers), and evaluation (how far you got, and what the results showed).
2. **Website/Materials** Tour: (10 minutes): Along with showing the project in depth, try to convey with examples what the process was, what you learned, what the kids learned, what some of the high points were.
3. **Questions/Answers**: (10 minutes): Clarifying aspects of the presentation, etc, so that everyone can get a clear sense of what the model you used was and how they might apply it.
4. **Conclusion**: What you'll be doing next Fall with this (if anything).
